## “Going Deeper”

### Monday - Mark 2:13-17

- How do the teachers of the law react to Jesus eating with tax collectors and sinners?
- How does Jesus respond? Why is that significant for you?

### Tuesday - Mark 5:1-20

- How does this illustrate the terrible nature of demon possession?
- What does this teach about Jesus’ ability to deliver?

### Wednesday - Exodus 32:1-35

- What parallels do you see between this and Mark 9:14-29?
- What was the consequence for the unfaithfulness of the Israelites?

### Thursday - Mark 1:40-45

- What parallels do you see between this and Mark 9:14-29?
- How is the leper’s question different from that of the desperate father? Which do you find yourself asking?

### Friday - Numbers 11:4-35

- How are the Israelites and their behavior described?
- How does the Lord respond to complaints and doubt?

### Saturday - John 15:1-8

- What does Jesus mean when He tells His followers to “*remain in me?*”
- What changes do you need to make in light of this?

### Memorize - Mark 9:23-24

*“If you can?” said Jesus. “Everything is possible for one who believes.” Immediately the boy’s father exclaimed, “I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!”*
